PROJECT PURPOSE

The mission of libraries has significantly evolved from the “warehouses for books” model to that of vibrant centers of active learning that would not have been imagined when the current library building was opened. 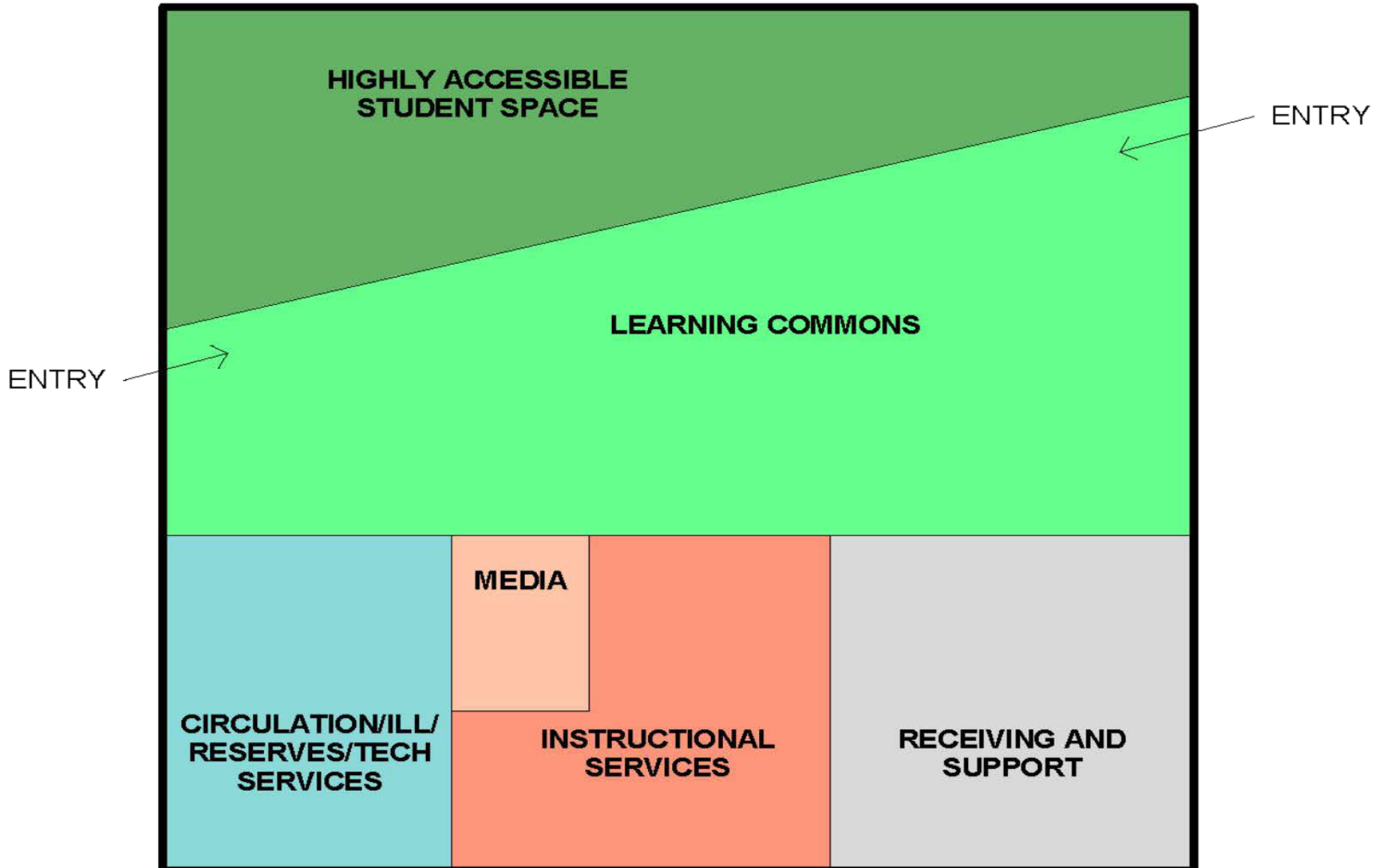

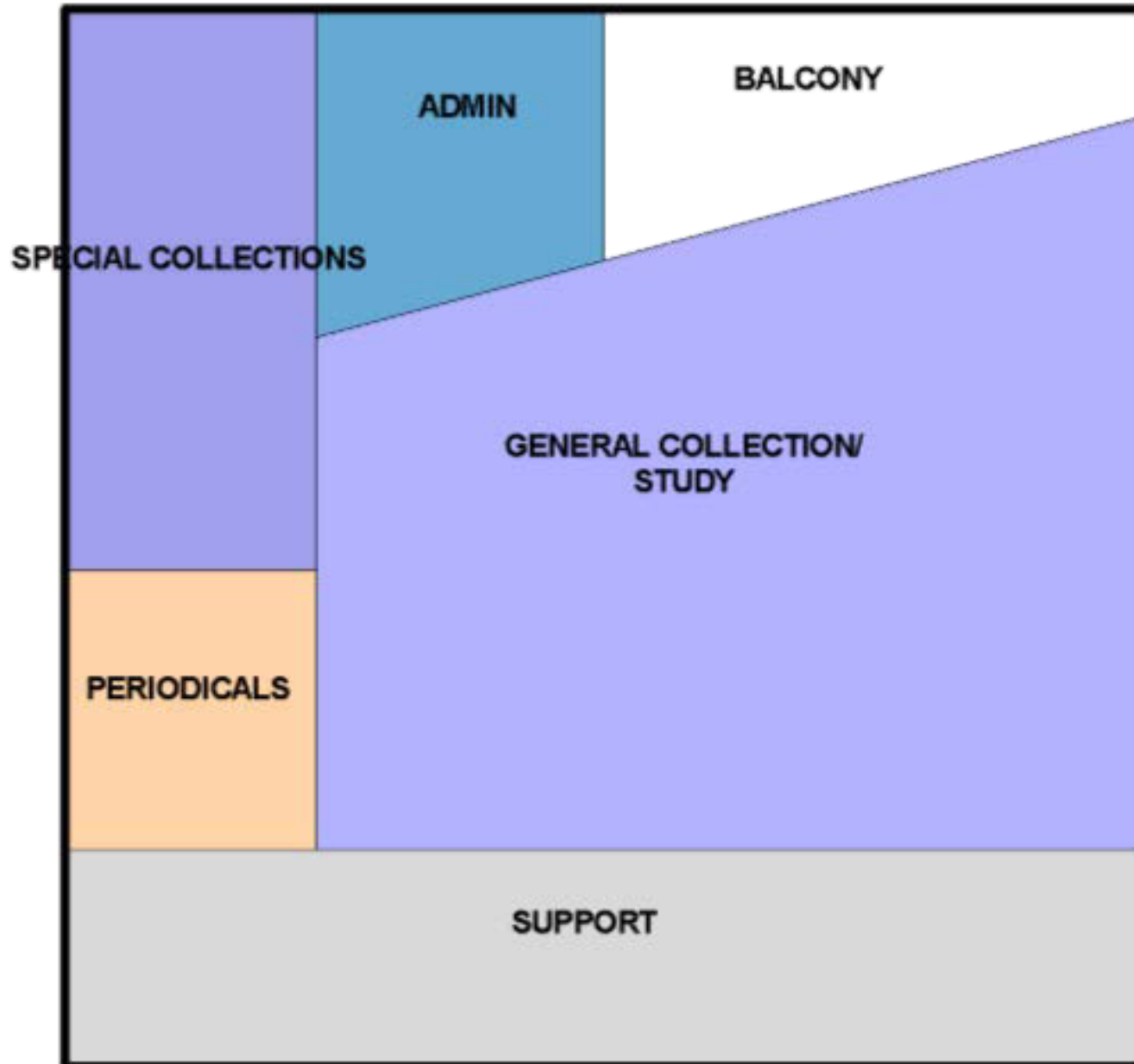





PROJECT BUDGET

The project budget includes site development costs such as 40 parking spaces and an allowance for plaza development; the construction cost of the building – enclosed space and balcony, construction contingency; furniture and equipment and indirect costs which include architectural and engineering fees and material testing etc.
