- 3 In the box under "Subscriber SSN or Member ID," enter your student ID number. If your student ID number is fewer than 9 digits long, please add zeros at the beginning of the number when typing it in this box. For example, if your student ID is S12345, enter 000S12345.
- 4 Under "Subscriber Home Zip Code," enter the ZIP code supplied to your school when you registered. This should be the ZIP code for your local U.S. address.
- 5 In the box "Subscriber Date of Birth," enter your date of birth, using the format mm/dd/yyyy.
- 6 Click "Next," then follow the prompts to create a username and password (password must be at least 8 alphanumeric characters) and enter three security questions and answers.
- Confirm your information. You may then log in to the site with the username and password you just created. From the Home page, click the link, "Print or Request an ID Card."
