This letter is to inform you that your mid-term grade is below 80% in N206. It is imperative that you schedule an appointment with the Program Director and/or Academic Advisor to identify a plan to succeed in the BSN program.

As stated in the Grambling State University School of Nursing Student Handbook an 80% is required to be successful in this/these course(s). Please refer to the policy below:

In order to be retained and progress in the professional nursing curriculum, a student must make a grade of "C" or better in all courses in the professional nursing program.

Dismissal from the nursing program will occur whenever a student has either/or:

- 1. Failed the second enrollment of the same nursing course in the professional component.
- 2. Failed the second nursing course in the professional component. (Effective 1/2008)

In the professional segment, failure is defined as achievement of a grade of "W", "D" or "F" and if the student withdraws from the course with a failing grade at the time of withdrawal. (Effective 8/10). Enrollment in a nursing course is defined as completion of any unit examination in that course. Students must earn a minimum theory grade of "C" or better and a satisfactory clinical component evaluation in order to successfully complete any clinical/lab course and progress to the next level nursing courses.
