I. PURPOSE/OBJECTIVE

To provide health care services to employees, minors and visitors.

II. STATEMENT OF POLICIES

In the event an accident occurs on the premises of Grambling State University, the employees of the university and any visitors to campus will be provided first-aid treatment only.

A. TREATMENT

First aid treatment will be provided to employees, visitors (anyone visiting the university in an official and unofficial capacity) and any GSU sponsored camp attendees. For further treatment needs the patient will be referred to an emergency room or private physician.

B. EXPENSES

All expenses incurred, including transportation is the responsibility of the individual or the parent/sponsoring program (if minor).

C. INSURANCE

All non-university sponsored camps must provide insurance for camp participants prior to the beginning of the camp. All such participants must have Medical History and Consent to Treatment forms on file with the sponsoring camp/agency.
