I. PURPOSE/OBJECTIVE

To provide medical emergency health care services to all GSU students.

II. STATEMENT OF POLICY

A medical emergency on campus requires a call to the University Police Department at (318) 274-2222 or (318) 274-2219 (24 hours a day). Students can also use the Emergency icon on their GSAFE App for medical emergencies. University police will contact the local ambulance service and/or Ruston Fire Department Emergency Medical Services (EMS). EMS will determine the extent of the emergency and treat or transfer the patient to a local medical facility.

If your problem is not a critical emergency, but you do need assistance after hours, do one of the following:

- 1. Call or go to a private physician of your choice;
- 2. If you live in a residence hall, consult staff assigned; or
- 3. Call or go to one of the local after-hours clinics.
