PROCEDURES FOR STUDENT CLUBS AND ORGANIZATIONS

To establish guidelines for organizations to be recognized as an official university student club or organization.

STEPS

- 1. Organizations should contact the Office of Student Clubs & Organizations to secure the appropriate paperwork/forms for the purpose of registering.
- 2. After the appropriate paperwork/forms have been approved, the organization may reserve University facilities for organization recruiting and formation.
- 3. An organization must submit a constitution, the statement of purpose of the organization, as well as its type of membership, prior to its official recognition.
- 4. An organization must have a minimum of ten (10) members inclusive of officers. (Exceptions are academic organizations sponsored by a particular academic college).
- 5. Each member must have a minimum individual cumulative GPA of 2.0 unless the organization's constitution requires a higher GPA.
- 6. Officers must be enrolled in twelve (12) or more semester hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above as required by the constitution when elected and while in office.
- 7. All student organizations are required to have a full-time Grambling State University faculty or staff member as their advisor of record.
- 8. Advisors must attend all meetings and functions provided by the organization they advise.
- 9. All elected officers shall be undergraduate students unless the organization is a graduate organization or club.
- 10. Organizations/clubs are prohibited from accruing outstanding debt to any department of the University or outside entity. All funds belonging to the organization must be deposited into the University's Accounting Office.
